

## Information and advice

We normally have a stock of traded in units from mainly European operators. Our used Sideloaders are carefully checked and refurbished before being shipped out again and they are considered to be excellent value for money. Most of them are also being sand blasted and repainted and thus look good as well. This is not a minor point, when our buyers present the newly purchased Sideloaders to their customers!

Special emphasis is put on safety features such as tyres, brakes and safety valves. Cranes are carefully checked for oil leaks and dis-alignment and if necessary seals, bushes, bearings and pins are being replaced. New tyres are fitted if the old ones are less than 50%. We can also add certain optional equipment to the unit on customers request, as we only start the reconditioning process until after the order is received! This means that each unit can be customised to most needs.

All second hand refurbished HAMMARs are covered by a **3 Months Guarantee** against hidden defects and bad workmanship. Each purchase includes the assistance of a Hammar Technical Supervisor, who will supervise the fitting of the pump unit onto your tractor head. He will also train your drivers/operators in the correct and safe operating procedures of the HAMMAR.

A reprinted and up-to-date **Illustrated Spare Parts List** is attached to the **Owner's Manual** included in the delivery, if available.

We at Hammar Maskin see our second hand Sideloaders as a very good alternative to a new unit. Especially for the first-timer, or for a smaller operation, that cannot justify the investment of a new Sideloader.

Please note that all sales of Second Hand HAMMAR equipment are done on a strict **First-come-first-served-basis**. Your firm order and deposit payment will secure your selected unit!

In the choice between buying new or second hand, the investment cost is normally the guiding factor. We refurbish the used HAMMARs, but we have to do it within a certain cost frame to keep the equipment in an attractive price level. Used equipment is not and will never be the same as new, but is still the right choice for many operators!

New equipment can easily work for 2-3 years with only monthly service intervals and it can be ordered to the buyer's exact specifications and needs. Such requirements might have to be sacrificed when buying second hand. Maintenance and services for a used unit have to be done more carefully and in closer intervals, to avoid unnecessary and unplanned downtime. In the end it is up to you, to decide what you need and want!

As we are gladly trading in older HAMMAR sideloaders as part payment for new equipment, we normally have stock of these used sideloaders that used to be purchased mainly by Scandinavian and European buyers. Today the major part of our second hand sales is done overseas - and for a very good reason.
